	does not have to quarantine if s/he does not exhibit any symptoms.
	Any person, who is identified as a close contact and has tested positive for
	COVID-19 and fully recovered in the past three months, does not have to
	quarantine if s/he does not exhibit any symptoms.
	 Any person, who is identified as a close contact <u>and</u> has not been fully
	vaccinated, will have to quarantine.
	*Note: Contact tracing will not be required on buses due to ventilation procedures.

	 Quarantine away from school for 7 calendar days. May return on day 8 if
	symptom-free and received a negative COVID-19 test** on day 5, 6, or 7

	11 <u>if symptom-free.</u>
	Child lives in a house with someone that is positive, the child isolates for 10
	days, plus :
	 Quarantine away from school for 7 additional calendar days. May return
	on day 8 if symptom-free and received a negative COVID-19 test** on
	day 5, 6, or 7 of quarantine window. OR
	 Quarantine away from school for additional 10 calendar days. May
	return on day 11 <u>if symptom-free.</u>

international travel	Quarantine away from school for 7 calendar days. May return on day 8 if
	symptom-free and received a negative COVID-19 test** on day 5, 6, or 7 of the
	quarantine window.

	 Quarantine away from school for 10 calendar days. May return on day 11 if
	<u>symptom-free.</u>
	Days will not count against attendance. Schoolwork will be provided.

2 or more positive cases in a classroom within 48 hours	 Two or more positive cases from separate households are defined as an outbreak by ADPH. The entire class will be quarantined for 10 calendar days
	 Quarantine away from school for 7 calendar days. May return on day 8 if symptom-free and received a negative COVID-19 test** on day 5, 6, or 7 of the quarantine window.
Multiple classrooms (>50%) with one positive case in a school	Logistics will provide sanitization/disinfection for the affected area
15% of students identified as a positive case	 School is closed for 5 calendar days ***Note: Rules for quarantine/isolation of positive cases and close contacts will still apply
